

Eligibility Criteria and Admission Process for Admission to Integrated B.Sc.-M.Sc. in Physics

1. Eligibility Criteria

Eligibility is one of the very important details that should be taken care of while applying to any course. Therefore, an eligibility criterion for admission to Integrated B.Sc.-M.Sc. in Physics has been provided as below:

- (i) The student must have passed 10+2 class from the recognized board in 60% marks or equivalent grade in aggregate.
- (ii) The student must have studied physics and mathematics subjects in 10+2 class.
- (iii) The student must have a score of at least 60% marks in Physics in 10+2 class.
- (iv) The student must meet the age limit of the University.

2. Admission Process

The admission for Integrated B.Sc.-M.Sc. in Physics course will be made on the basis of merit of Qualifying Examination as per reservation roster followed by the University. The student must qualify their eligibility criteria for the admission.

3. Counseling and display of merit list

All candidates will be called for counseling on the basis of merit of Qualifying Examination, and intimated through e-mail and phone call. First merit list of the selected candidates will be displayed on the notice board and website of the University on the date of counseling before 5 PM.
